SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES



Families will be asked to confirm their eligibility status once each calendar year.

Eau Claire Parks and Recreation Scholarships apply to youth programs and pool admissions only. Must live within the Eau Claire City limits. Scholarship applications MUST be submitted to the Recreation Administrative Office by email at recscholarships@eauclairewi.gov or in-person Monday - Friday from 8am-5pm at 915 Menomonie Street.

ELIGIBILITY: Any resident living within the City of Eau Claire boundaries currently receiving Federal, State, or Local assistance are eligible. If you live in a Township, different county, or different city you will not be eligible for the program. The following must be submitted when applying for the scholarship:

Applicants must provide proof of one of the below, a photo ID, and a piece of mail:

1. Proof of Effective Food Share or Badger Care Quest Program:

- Provide letter showing current proof of Food Share Quest.
- Applicant must contact Great Rivers Consortium at <u>1-888-283-0012</u> and request a "Print Screen" stating the family's name and current food share allowance/effective date.
- No Food Share or Badger Care cards will be accepted as proof.

OR

Proof of ECASD Free Lunch Program:

- Provide paperwork showing entry into the ECASD Free Lunch Program. Paperwork must be from the most recent school year.
- Applicant must contact ECASD Food and Nutrition at 715-852-3000 to request a copy of the letter.

OR

Proof of other Federal, State, or Local assistance:

- Provide letter showing effective date of assistance you receive.
- Applicant must contact the organization and request a copy of letter or other document showing effective date.

2. Proof of Identification:

Must show a valid Photo ID.

3. Proof of Address:

Piece of mail with your current mailing address.

4. Completed Scholarship Application
