The concrete trail will be installed in June by Skidsteer Guy, and boardwalks out to the viewsheds over Half Moon Lake will be installed by MN Boardwalk, to be completed by October. 



SUBJECT: Recommendation for Approval of Easements at Jeffers Road

Please place an item on the next Waterways & Parks Commission agenda to discuss and make a recommendation on the above-referenced item.

Lead New

The City has received a request from Xcel Energy for an electrical underground distribution easement to be located on the west side of Jeffers Road at two locations. Following is detail describing the two proposed easement locations along with maps displaying where the proposed easements are to be located.

The first easement proposal is to be located on the west side of Jeffers Road, Parcel No. 14-0746, generally located south of County Line Road and west of Jeffers Road. Xcel needs to replace the existing transmission line running north-south along Jeffers Road due to the construction of the multi-use trail.

The easement area being requested in this first proposal is approximately 1.74 acres (approximately 30 feet in width, the length of the parcel) west of the existing transmission line. Xcel's installation of the overhead facility will be to auger new poles in west of the existing poles and relocate the existing overhead. There are trees located on the southern portion of the site, which may be impacted in this process.


The second easement proposal is to be located on the west side of Jeffers Road, Parcel No. 14-2321, generally located north of Stephi Road and west of Jeffers Road. Similar to the above location, Xcel needs to replace the existing transmission line running north-south along Jeffers Road due to the construction of the multi-use trail.

The easement area being requested in this second proposal is approximately 0.06 acres (approximately 28 feet in width, the length of the parcel) west of the existing transmission line. Xcel's installation of the overhead facility will be to auger new poles in west of the existing poles and relocate the existing overhead. There will be no impact to trees in this process.

This item for the two proposed easements at Jeffers Road would be presented to Plan Commission on Monday, May 1, 2023. Following the Plan Commission's approval, the City Council would then review a resolution to grant the two easements at the Tuesday, May 9, 2023, Legislative Session.

City staff recommends approval of the two easement agreements.


