NARRATIVE:

Eau Claire Fire Department responded to 3323 Seymour Rd for a report of a structure fire. While units were enroute dispatch advised there were multiple callers and everyone was reported out of the structure.

Upon arrival Engine 10 company reported a working fire and deployed attack lines to quickly extinguish the fire. Additional crews assisted in the search of the structure and reported it to be unoccupied. Extensive fire spread throughout the mobile home led to crews performing overhaul to ensure all hot spots were extinguished. ECFD inspectors responded to conduct the cause and origin investigation. Xcel energy assisted in securing the utilities. Red Cross responded to assist two adults, four children, two dogs, and one cat that were displaced. There were no reported injuries at the time of this report.
