CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Develop procedures for responding to vomiting and diarrheal events. Specifically actions that employees must take to minimize the spread of contamination. Correct By: 08-Jun-2022

CODE CITATION: 2-501.11 Clean-up of Vomiting and Diarrheal Events.

A FOOD ESTABLISHMENT shall have procedures for EMPLOYEES to follow when responding to vomiting or diarrheal events that involve the discharge of vomitus or fecal matter onto surfaces in the FOOD ESTABLISHMENT. The procedures shall address the specific actions EMPLOYEES must take to minimize the spread of contamination and the exposure of EMPLOYEES, CONSUMERS, FOOD, and surfaces to vomitus or fecal matter. OBSERVATION: The camp operator has not made written arrangements for medical care of campers and camp staff by a physician.

CORRECTIVE ACTION(S): Provide arrangements for medical care for campers and camp staff by a staff physician or consulting physician. Correct By: 10-Jun-2022

CODE CITATION: ATCP 78.19(1)(a) Before a camp opens for the first time, and at least annually thereafter, the camp operator shall make written arrangements for medical care of campers and camp staff by a staff physician or consulting physician and for emergency admissions to a designated hospital.

Note: It is recommended that a parent's or guardians written consent for emergency medical care be secured by the camp direct or prior to or upon the camper's arrival at camp.
