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Introduction

This report is a summary of the 2020 demographic data compiled from the 2020 Decennial Census Data as well as the 2017-2021 American Community Survey. The 2020 Census Data is collected every 10 years while the American Community Survey data is collected every year in selected areas and estimated for the rest of the country. Because of its accuracy, when Decennial Census Data was available, it was used.

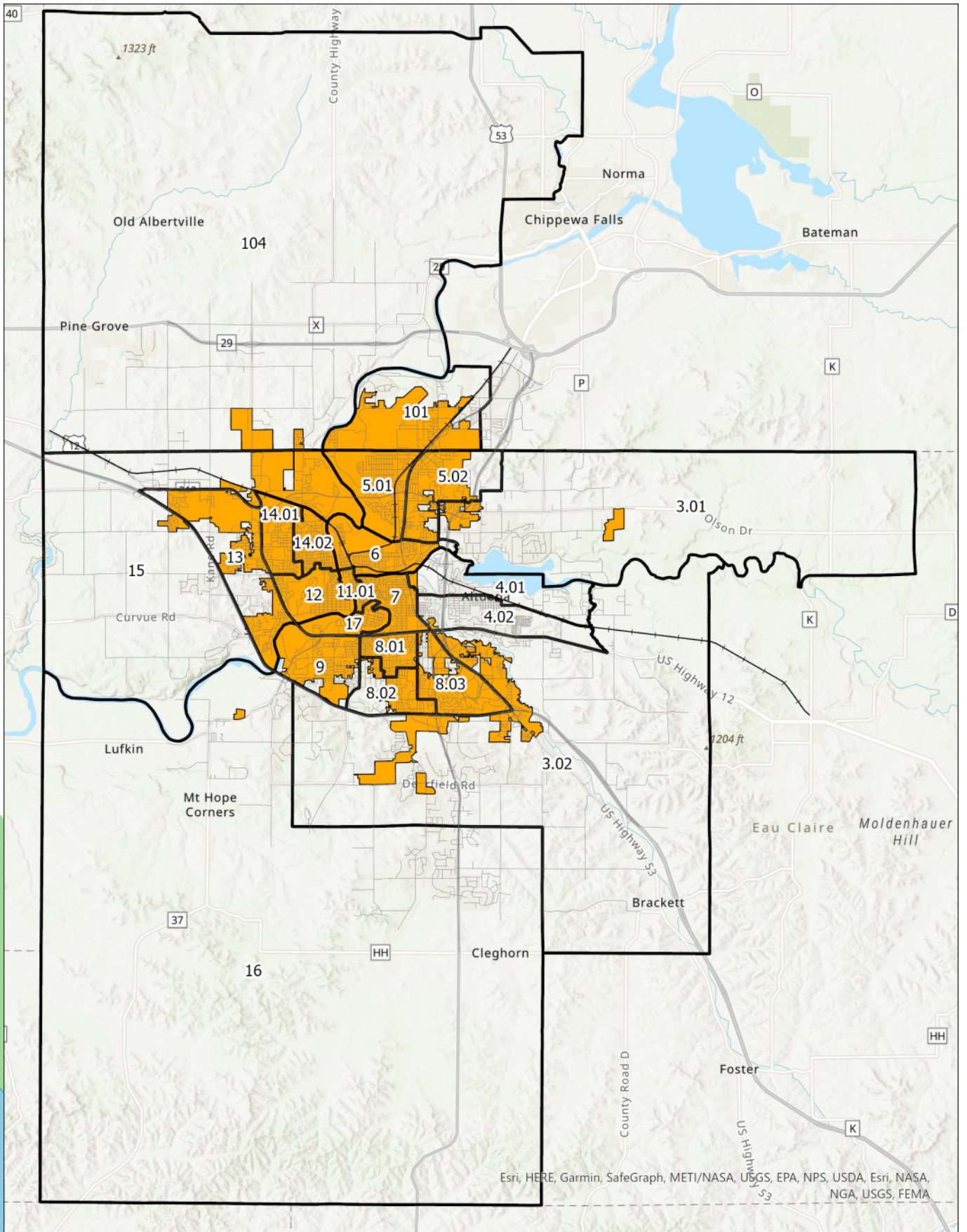
It should also be noted that the Census tracts that occupy the City of Eau Claire are much larger and reach beyond city limits as shown on page 4. Census tracts are subdivisions of cities or counties that are used to gather Census Data. The City of Eau Claire specifically has two tracts that reach into Chippewa county; tract 101 and 104. This has an effect on population density and includes data outside of the City of Eau Claire. **The full size of the tracts can be seen on page 2.**

It is also important to note that this report focuses on frequently requested data statistics. Additional information is available on the Census Bureau's website (www.census.gov). On this site, there are further subdivisions at the "block group" and "block" levels.

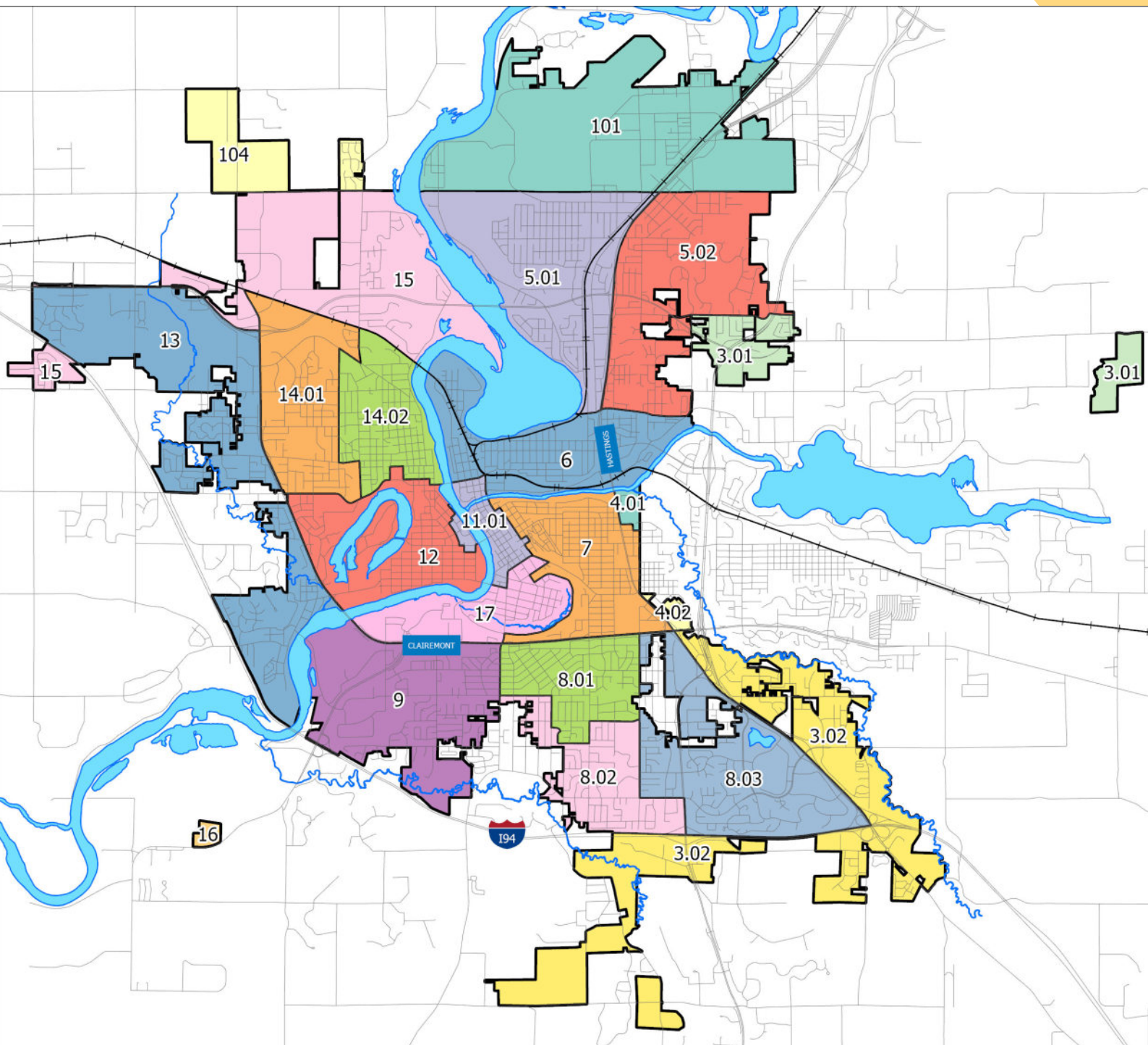
EAU CLAIRE CITY LIMIT

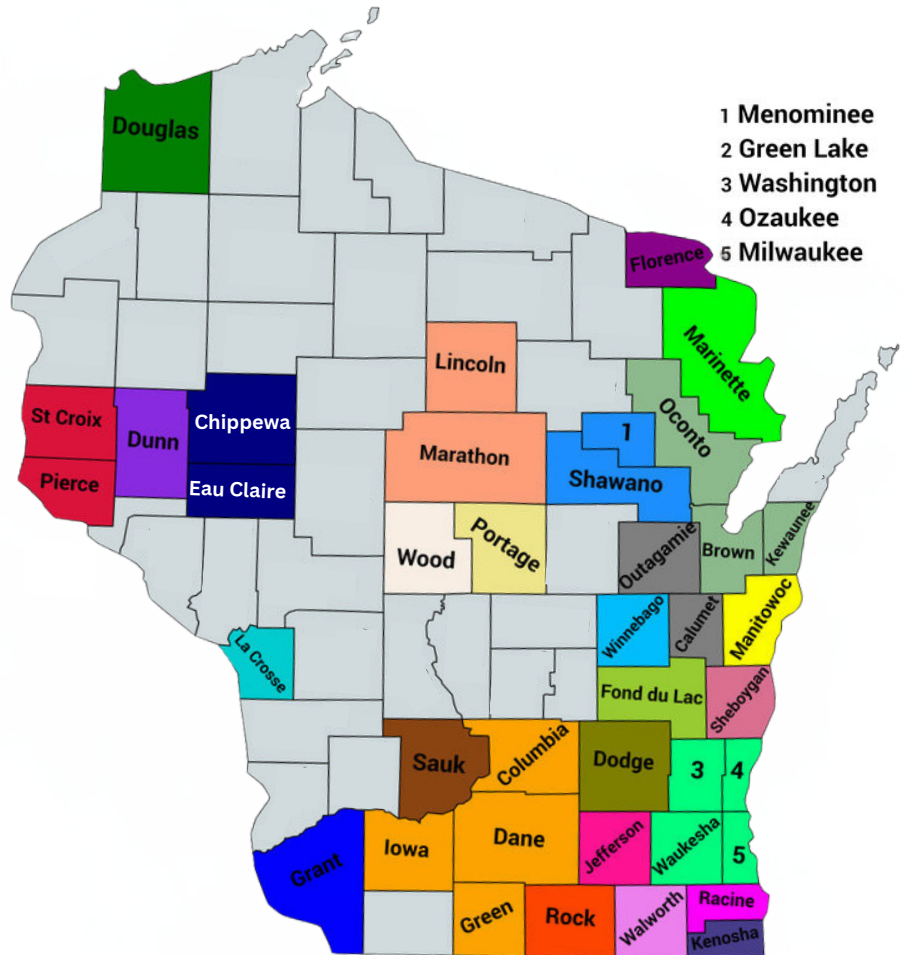
2020 Census Tract Boundaries





























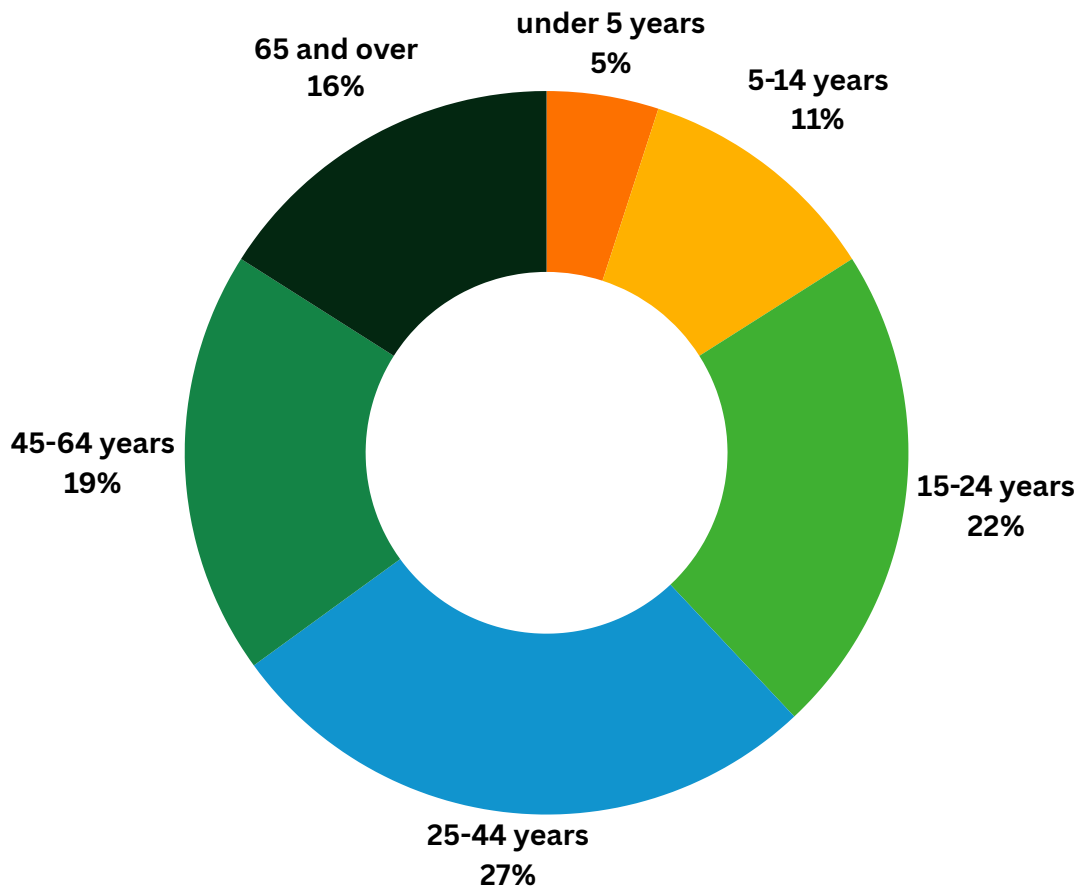

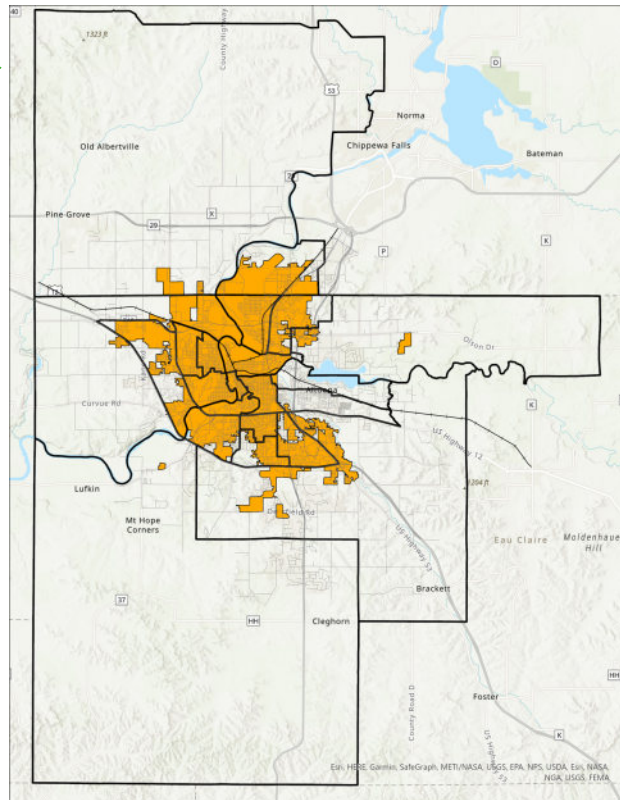

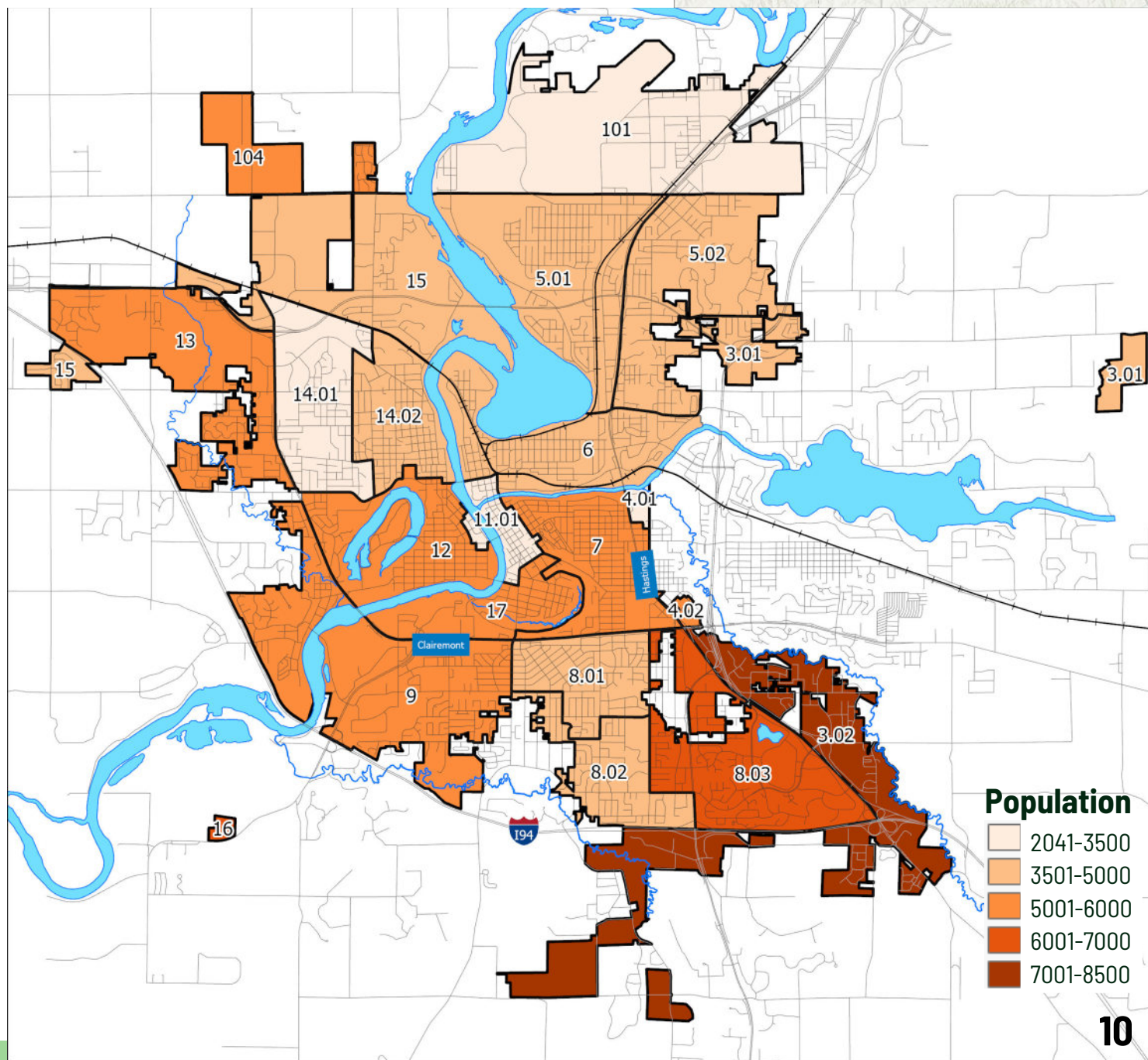

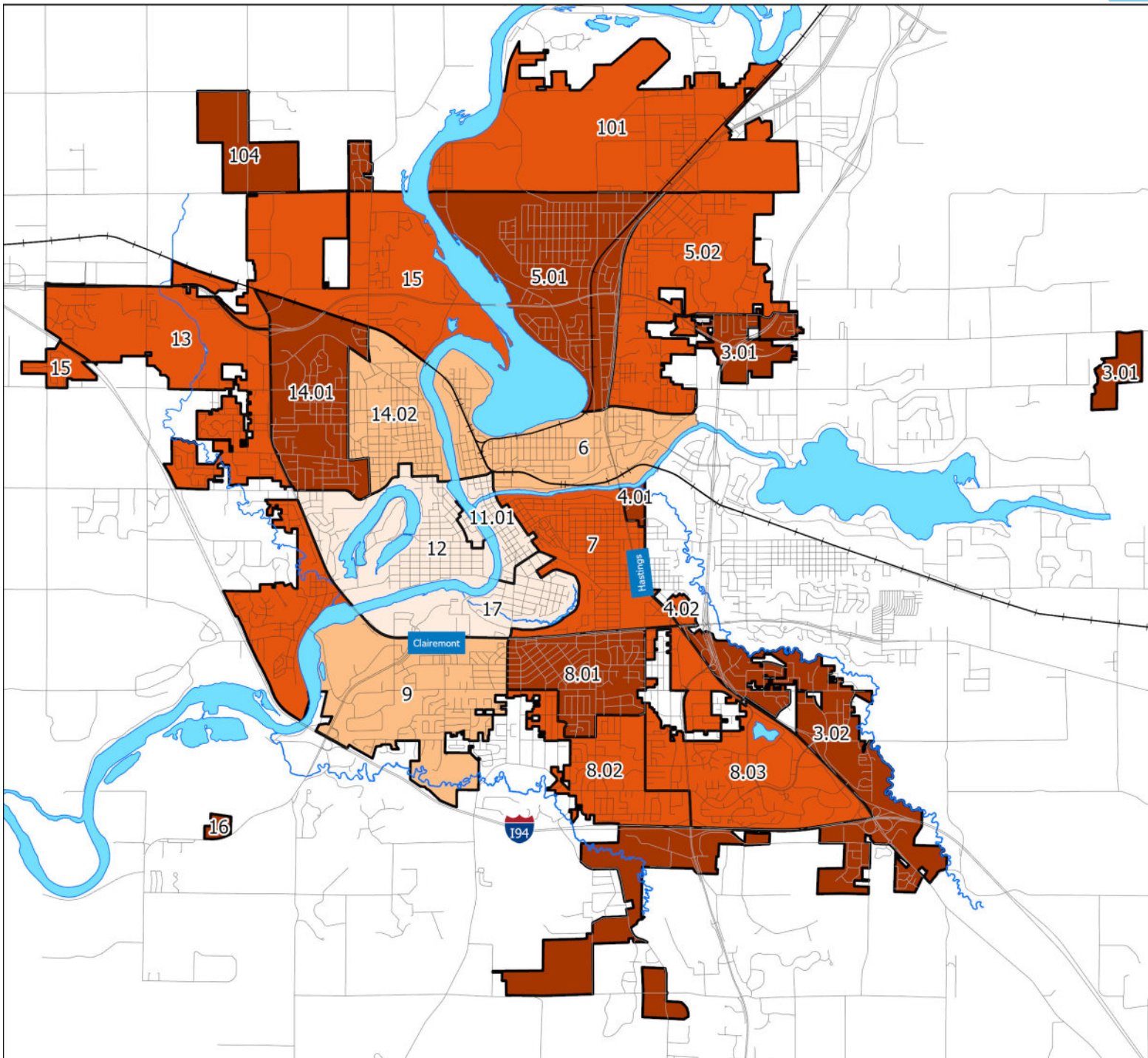

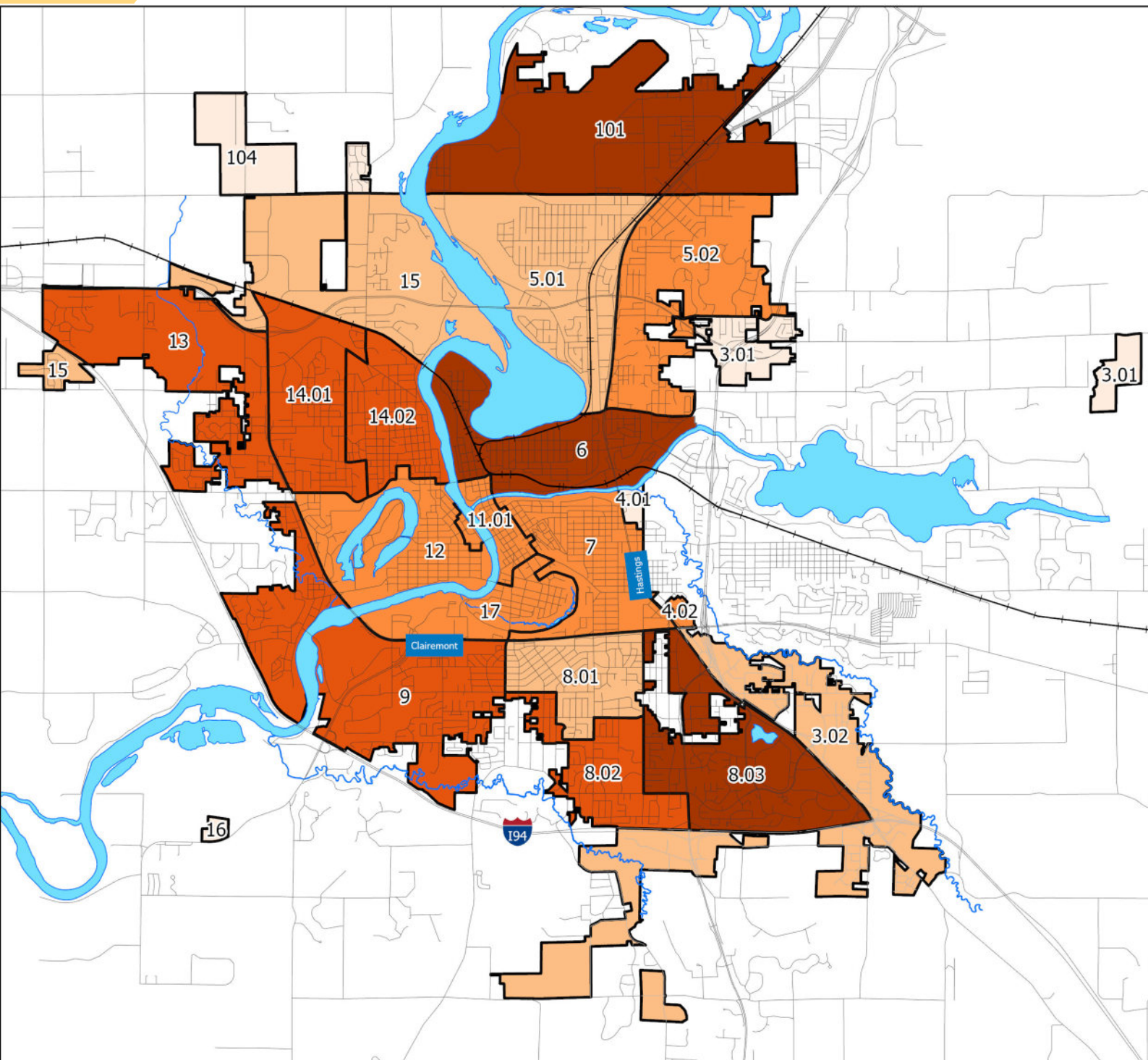

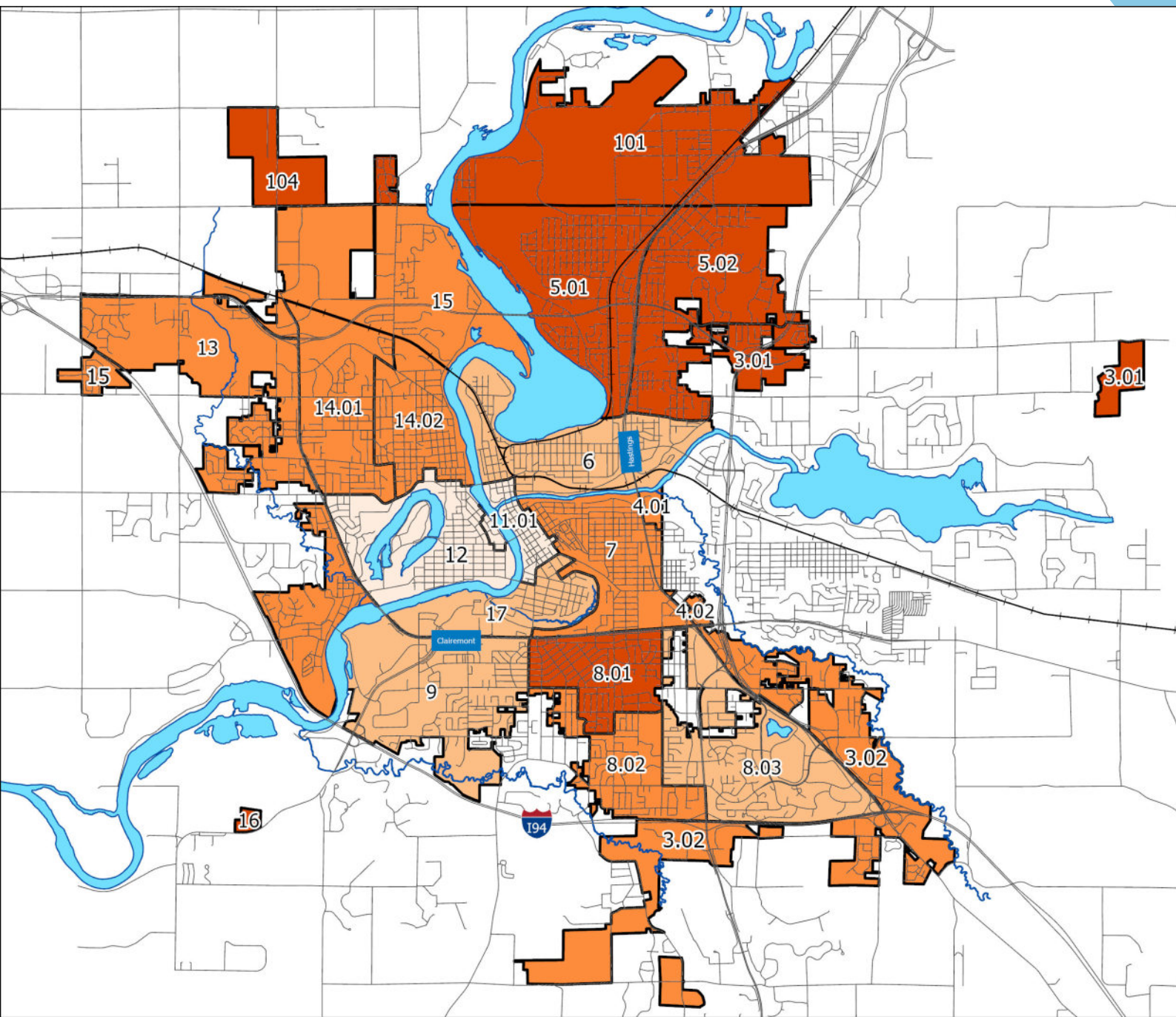

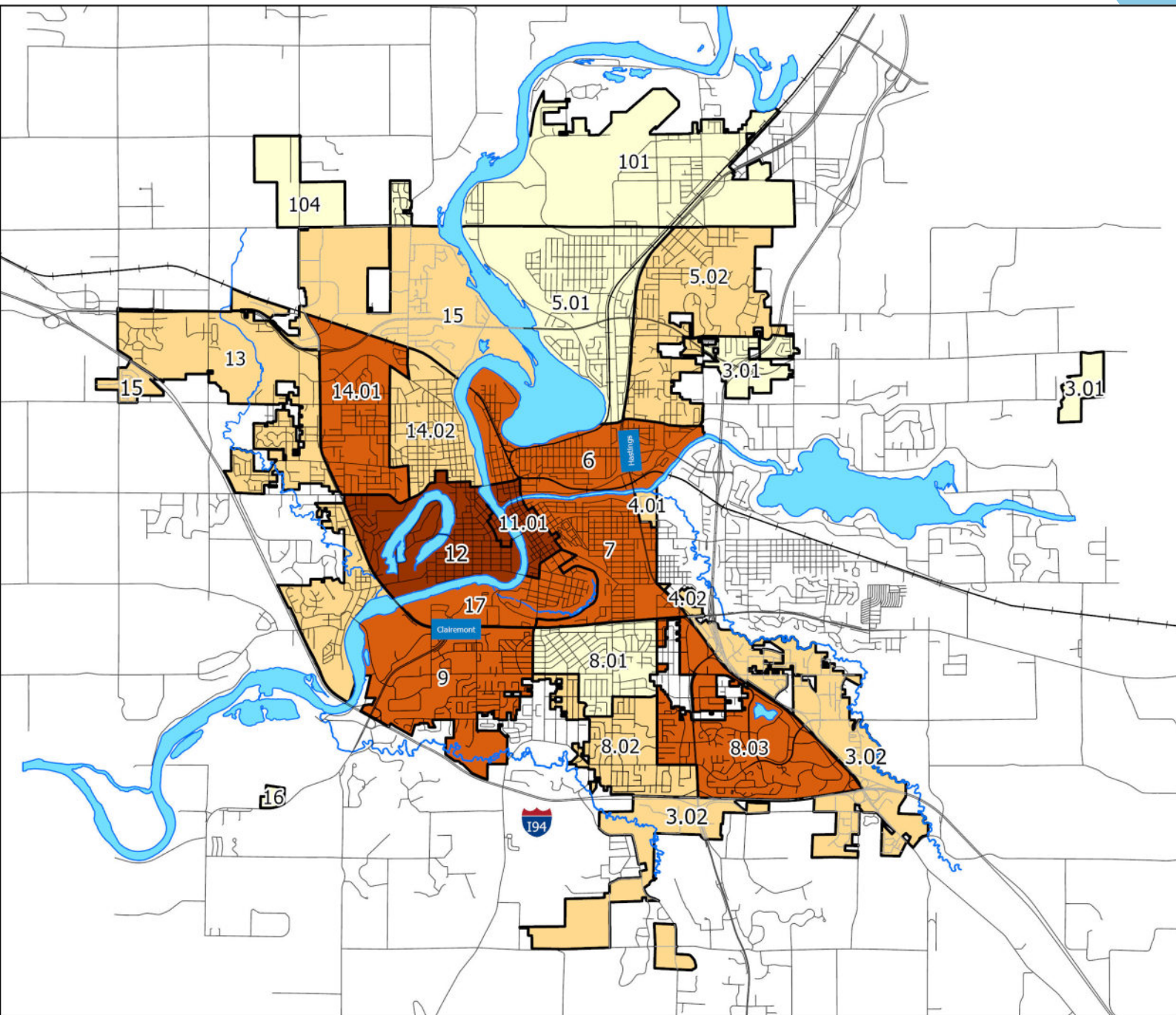

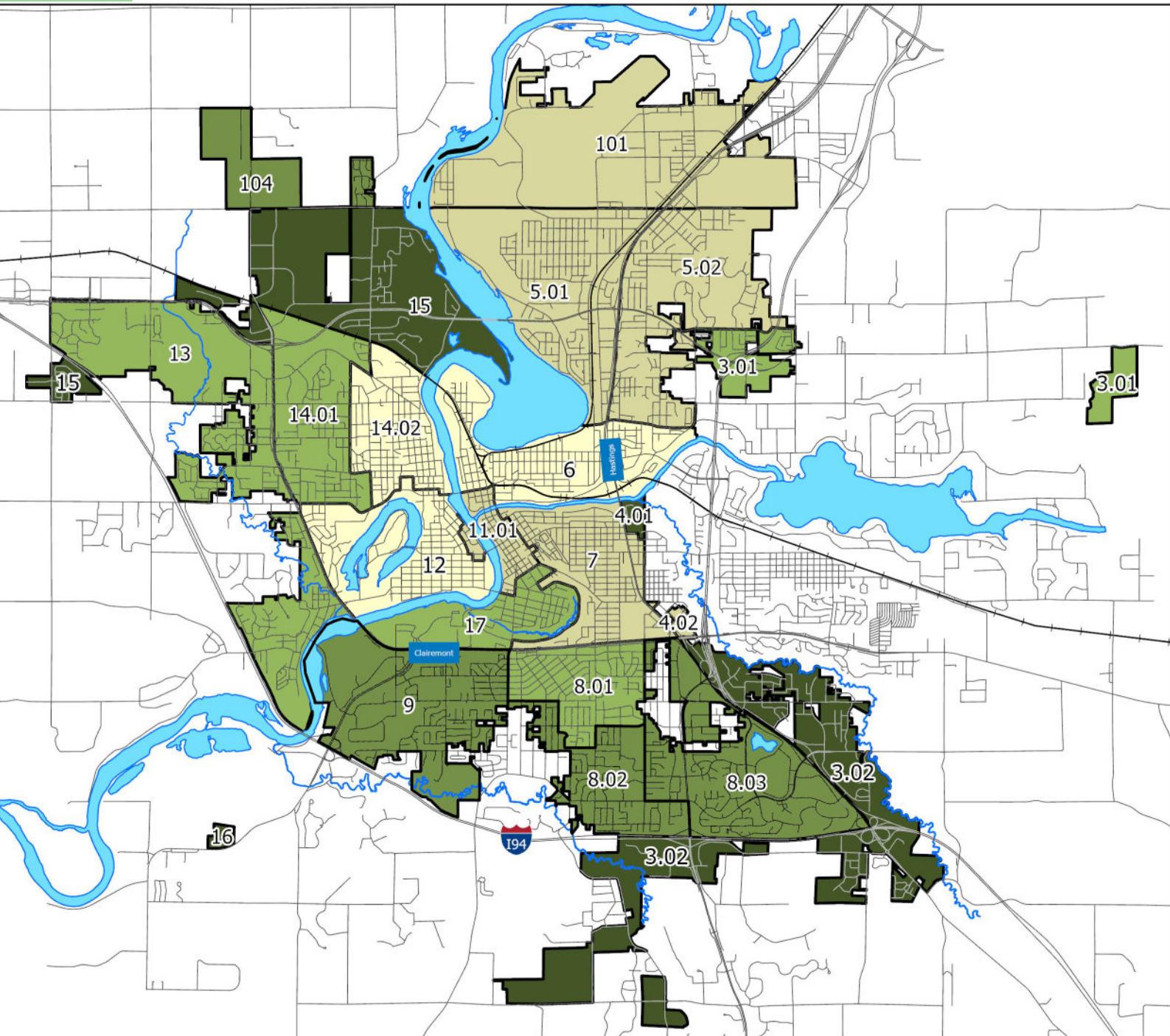

Median Home Value by Tract

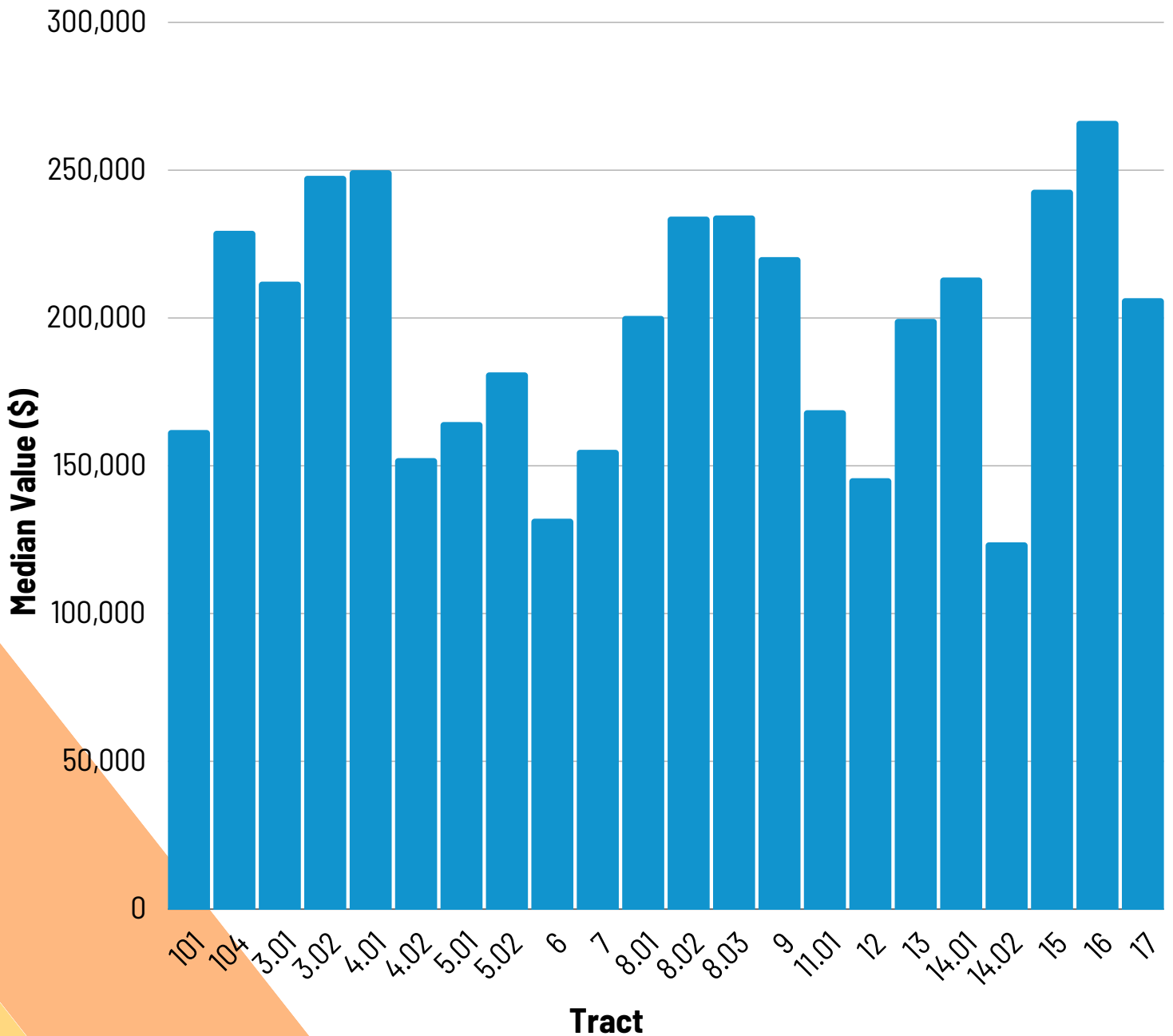
Median Home Value (\$)

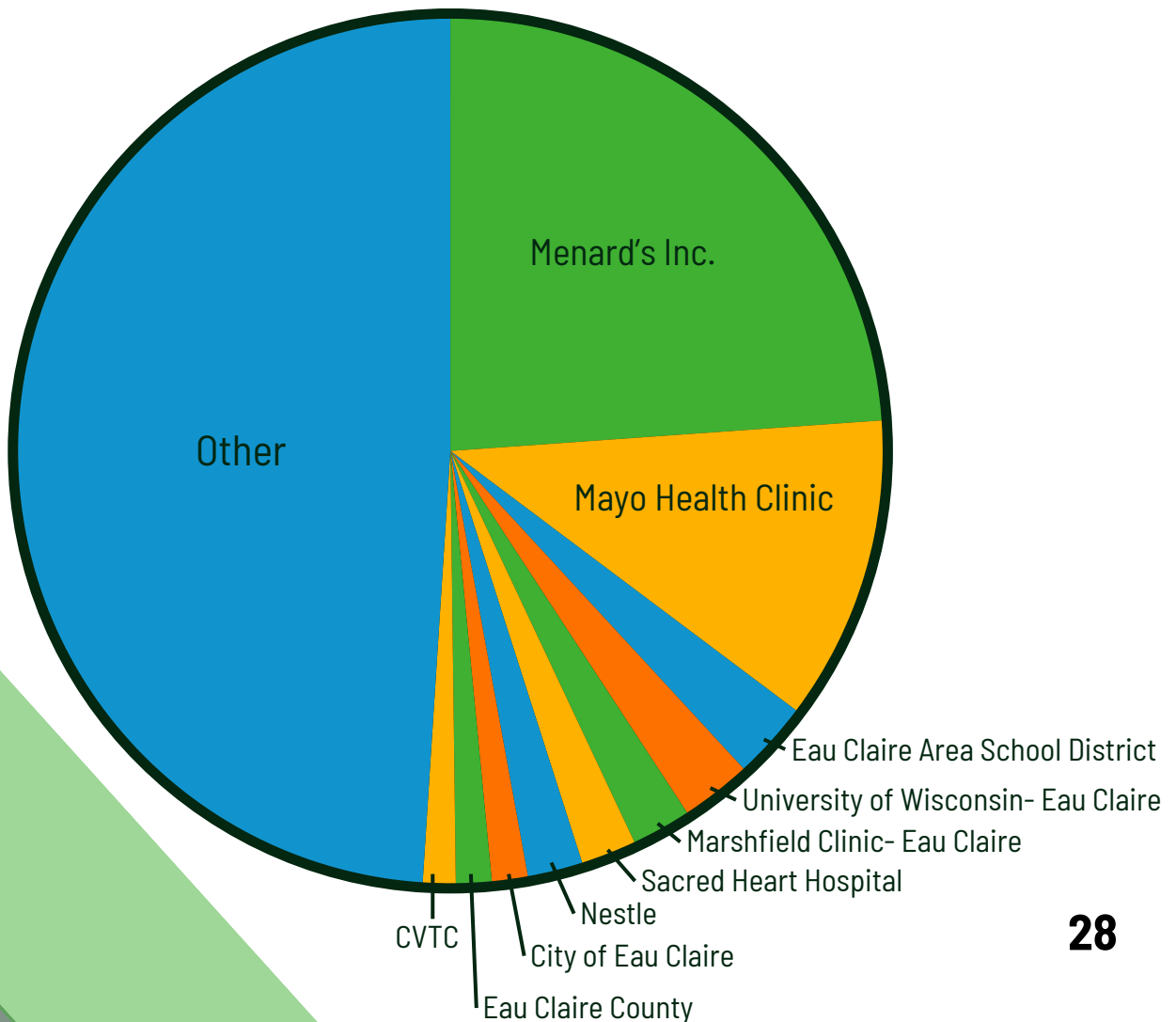
