	The Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a structure fire Thursday evening on the South side.
	Truck 5 and Medic 6 arrived to find smoke showing from several windows of a 4 unit apartment building and made entry into the basement of the building. Fire was quickly located and extinguished while additional crews performed searches of the building and ventilated the smoke. An appliance and exhaust vents in the basement of one apartment sustained fire damage. Ventilation was required throughout the building.

The Eau Claire Communications Center and ECPD assisted with the incident.
