


Proposed Totals by Department for 2025








Proposed Capital Funding Distribution 2025-2029







Debt Limit







City Polices:

- As seen on the last slide, net direct debt should not exceed 3X the operating revenues of the City.
- Per State Statute: The City shall not exceed 5 percent of the equalized valuation of the taxable property in the municipality. Further, the City has an internal policy which seeks to remain below 3.5 percent.
- The total unassigned General Fund balance shall be maintained as of December 31 of each year equal to a minimum of 15 percent of the ensuing year's budgeted General Fund expenditures, with a target of 20 percent. Included in the unassigned fund balance is a working capital reserve equal to ten percent of the ensuing year's General Fund expenditures to provide funds for reasonable cash flow needs.
