How To Comb Out Lice

Wash and Condition Hair

Washing the hair helps soften it for easier combing. Lice removal works best on wet hair.



Detangle With Wide-Tooth Comb

2 Gently comb hair with a wide-toothed comb to remove tangles and knots.



Remove Lice and Nits Using a Nit Comb

Use a nit comb or other fine-tooth comb to remove lice and eggs (nits) from hair.



Clean The Comb(s)

Remove lice and debris from the combs.

Lice cannot live on the combs, but you can wash and sterilize the combs as desired.



Repeat

After each treatment, check the hair and repeat combing steps to remove lice and nits every 2-3 days for the next 2-3 weeks or until all lice are removed.
