The ECFD responded to a report of a possible CO poisoning. An update from the Comm Center indicated there were multiple victims and there were individuals still inside. In addition there was a report of a generator in the building that was the possible cause of the CO.

The on scene Firefighters used Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (air masks) to make entry into the building to search for victims.

2 adults were removed from the building and transported to an area hospital. 2 juveniles were already out of the building and they were transported to an area hospital. The levels of CO inside the building were at a life threatening level.

The building is currently being ventilated to remove the CO as of the time of this report.
