

**Municipal Ordinance requires
that all trees along streets be
planted and maintained to meet
public requirements**

Hedges are not allowed
between the sidewalk and curb,
and must be planted at least 5
feet in back of the sidewalk

No tree plantings or solid
hedges in these zones.
Individual shrubs shall not
exceed 30 inches in height.



Almost all streets within the city have rights-of-way that extend back of the curb line. This area is public property and is generally used for utilities walks and landscaping. The width of this right-of-way varies considerably in different sections of the city. A permit from the City Forester is required prior to pruning, trimming, removing or otherwise treating trees or shrubs upon public areas.
