Narrative:

Eau Claire Fire and Rescue was dispatched to a structure fire at Boxx Sanitation at 5:29 p.m. When units arrived on scene they reported a fire inside the middle to rear area of a building that stores garbage and recyclables. The building is detached and is approximately 100'x100'. A second alarm requesting more resources to the scene was called. Burning embers and wind caused a grass/brush fire near Short Street and the bike trail. Township Fire Department was called to assist with the grass/brush fire. Approximately 40 firefighters were on scene extinguishing the fire at Boxx Sanitation and grass/brush fire. Township Fire Department, Chippewa Fire District, and Altoona Fire Department assisted Eau Claire with mutual aid with coverage within the City during the fire. The Red Cross assisted with food and rehab for on scene fire crews. ECFD units are still on scene and will be throughout today extinguishing hot spots. The fire is under investigation. No civilian or firefighter injuries reported.
