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Narrative:

The ECFD responded to a report of a structure fire. Upon arrival first in crews encountered light smoke in the building. The Thermal Imaging cameras were used to locate a hot spot in an interior wall and ceiling. The interior Engine crews had to open up some interior walls, a part of a ceiling, and a part of a floor to located the the source of the fire/smoldering lumber. One 1.75 inch hose line was deployed for safety reason but it was not put into use. The fire was extinguished using water based fire extinguishers. Two family members were home at the the time and evacuated the building safely. The last unit cleared at 16:49 hours and the property was turned over to the home owner.
