### **Narrative:**

The Eau Claire Fire Department responded to a structure fire at 2033 Glenwood Ave Eau Claire.  
At 11:11pm. On Saturday July 5th 2014,

When Firefighters arrived they found fire in an attached triple care garage with two vehicles still in the garage. The home owner had used several fire extinguishers to try to put the fire out before firefighters and police arrived.

Firefighters use hose lines to quickly knock down the fire and were able to keep the fire from spreading into the home. The fire was under control in about 15 minutes.

Fire damage was limited to the garage area of the home and the two vehicles parked inside the garage.

There were five occupants in the home at the time of the fire. They stated they smelled smoke and went to investigate and that is when they found the fire in the garage and called 911.

All five occupants in the home at the time of the fire were able to evacuate the home without injuries.  
Firefighters were on the scene for about two hours and the occupants were able to return to the home after the fire.
